2024 year in review

Medical outreach in Irrua, Nigeria

On May 18, 2024, KWH Foundation participated in a medical-outreach collaboration with the Department of Family Medicine in Irrua, Nigeria. The initiative reflected KWH's commitment to practical community care and to partnerships that bring support closer to people.

Community priorities

Throughout the year, KWH's public mission centred on settlement support, youth and teen programming, women's empowerment, entrepreneurship learning and career workshops. These priorities became the base for the more structured workforce, education and wellbeing pathways developed in the following year.

How KWH worked

- Community-centred outreach and relationship building.
- Volunteer and partner participation to extend reach.
- Practical supports designed around real barriers to opportunity.
- A growing connection between humanitarian service, education and economic inclusion.

Organizational development

KWH used 2024 to strengthen the direction of its programs and clarify how community support could connect with skills development, settlement, entrepreneurship and wellbeing. This foundation

supported the later growth of KWH Academy and more defined workforce and community program streams.

Stewardship and financial transparency

KWH's accountability approach emphasizes approved budgets, documented spending, restricted-fund tracking, appropriate authorization, reliable records and periodic leadership oversight. Detailed financial statements are not reproduced in this public impact report. Financial records are maintained for governance, funder, accounting and legal review as applicable.

Looking ahead to 2025

- Create clearer pathways between training, employers and entrepreneurship supports.
- Expand programming for seniors, youth, newcomers and equity-deserving communities.
- Strengthen public communication, partnerships and outcome tracking.
- Develop job-ready learning through KWH Academy and community-based events.
